Archery: Whether you're interested in backyard recreation, competition target shooting, or bow hunting you'll enjoy learning about this fast growing sport. Learn the basics of equipment and safety. Experience the thrill of hitting the mark at the archery range.

Backyard Habitat: Would you like to learn how to make your property more appealing to wildlife? You'll learn how to plan for a safe and attractive backyard habitat. You will identify some of the most common wild backyard visitors plus spend some class time building a bluebird house to take home and become part of your backyard haven.

Basic Car Care: Worried about being stranded on the highway? Worry no longer. You will learn how to change a flat tire, what's involved in changing your oil, and other key elements vital to basic car maintenance. You don't want to miss this class.

Camping: Learn about the facets of simple family camping, including tents and sleeping bags, camp stoves, and lanterns, and other proper equipment.

Dog Training: Learn how to train woman's best friend. Throughout the training and demonstration, you will learn basic obedience and retrieving skills for working with your sporting dog or your faithful friend at home.

Flyfishing: Catch 'em on a fly! Master basic fly casting techniques and learn about lines, leaders, knots, and fly selection. Participants will become familiar with the necessary equipment for flyfishing and discover places to fish.

Golf: Learn the how-to basics of this enjoyable and relaxing outdoor sport. Techniques, equipment choice, and use will be taught.

Handguns: You will learn the proper handling, shooting positions, and techniques of using handguns. You will have time to practice your newfound skills.

Intro to Firearms: Learn about the different types, how they work and how to safely handle firearms. This is a great class for those that are afraid of firearms or know nothing about them. You will NOT be firing any firearms in this class.

Invasive Insects: The emerald ash borer has made its way to Butler County. This invasive insect, often referred to as EAB, has already killed and damaged 20 - 25 million ash trees since it was introduced into this country. The Department of Agriculture, DCNR, and other agencies consider this pest a true threat to the environment and the economy. Attend this session to learn about many different invasive species, such as EAB.

Kayaking: Learn the basic knowledge and skills needed to be safe on the water and enjoy kayaking. Topics include safety, equipment, preparation, strokes, maneuvering and much more.

Intro to Map & Compass: Participants will learn about different types of maps and specifically how to read and interpret a topographic map. The function and parts of a compass will be introduced. Once familiar with how to hold and read a compass, you'll be taught how to take a field bearing and a map bearing. In order to measure distance while in the field, all participants will measure their individual pace and learn how to apply this while using a map and compass to navigate. Hand-held GPS devices will also be briefly introduced. To practice newly acquired skills, participants will challenge themselves on a short course designed to challenge their understanding of distance, maps field bearing and map bearings. **(This will be a double session)**

Muzzleloading: Peer through a puff of smoke and experience the thrill of delayed discharge! In this introduction to the sport of shooting muzzle-loaders, you'll load, shoot, and fire this primitive firearm.

Outdoor Crafts: In this class you will be making couple different crafts that you will be able to take home with you. **(\$10 charge for class supplies).**

Powder Puff Tools: Are you intimidated with trying to tackle small jobs around your house because you don't know the difference in the various tools your husband or you owns. This class will help you learn the basics for getting familiar with the tools that you might need for some around the house jobs.

Rifles: Participants will learn proper handling of rifles, shooting position, and basic shooting techniques. There will be lots of practice time on the range.

Self Protection: If you travel alone, make those late night trips to the grocery store, or are just interested in basic self protection tips, this class is for you. Come and learn basic moves that every woman should know.

Shotgunning: You will become familiar with different types of shotguns, ammunition, and proper gun fitting. Time will be spent at the range where you will shoot clay birds. You will be amazed at how you feel when you break that clay bird!

Spinning: Learn how to spin your own thread like the pioneer women did. Start with sheep fur and create a spool of thread.

Talkin' Turkey: You'll have the opportunity to learn about wild turkey and its habits. Learn calling techniques, equipment, camouflage, and set-up techniques to improve your chances of seeing, photographing or bag one of these magnificent birds.

Tree Identification: Participants will discover the incredible diversity of trees that Pennsylvania is fortunate to have. Jennings staff will introduce specific features of trees that can aid in identification. These features include shape, bark, branching, buds and leaves. Interesting natural history facts and information related to the trees identified will be shared and observation skills, critical to tree identification, will be put to the test.
