Classes to choose from:

Wildlife Pest Control... This class covers the legal and practical basics of both fur trapping and dealing with problem wildlife around the home. Emphasis is placed on the use of the correct equipment, baits, & techniques to result in the capture of the proper animal while avoiding non-target catches.

Archery... Learn about this fast growing sport. Do you want to learn backyard recreation, competitive target shooting, or maybe you want to go bow hunting? You will learn how to select equipment that fits you. There will be lots of hands-on instruction. Experience the thrill of hitting the target!

Canoeing/Kayaking... After you learn about the types and styles of canoes used, you may also enjoy practicing paddle stroke techniques and safety procedures on the water.

Fishing... Develop basic skills needed to catch fish: casting, knot tying, lure selection, fish identification, fishing locations, and equipment choice and use.

Fly Fishing... You will learn the basics of fly fishing techniques. The course offers information which will help you select a rod and reel, line weights, baits, and lures.

Get Your Bearings... Getting lost in the woods will no longer be a threat to your outdoor adventures. In this course, you will learn how to read a compass and topographic maps.

Handgun Basics... The instructor will provide a broad spectrum of information about the operations and fundamentals of shooting handguns. At the end of this class, you will be able to safely shoot a variety of handguns.

Outdoor Survival Skills... Gain the knowledge, skill, and attitude that surviving an outdoor emergency requires. This course will deal with the mental things you need to know about survival as well as the physical aspects: food, water, and shelter.

Planting Food Plots to Attract Wildlife... Learn how to plant food plots to attract wildlife to your property. Food plots can be large or small...you can have one regardless of your property size. Discussion will revolve around planting food plots to attract deer, turkeys and other wildlife. Use of trail cameras for monitoring food plot use and activity will also be discussed.

Rifle Marksmanship... Learn to shoot .22 rim fire rifles and the fundamentals of marksmanship skills. Come join us for fun and action on the firing range!

Shotgunning/Trapshoot... You will become familiar with different types of shotguns, ammunition, proper gun fit, and gun cleaning. Time will be spent at the range where you will shoot clay birds.

Turkey Calling... The more experience you have using calls, the better your odds are for finding and taking turkeys. At this class you'll learn about turkeys, how to hunt, how to call and which tactics produce turkeys. In no time you will be confident that you can call in a turkey!

Woodworking for Wildlife... Nest boxes, bat houses, nesting platforms, shelves, and nesting baskets are some common types of artificial structures. 
