**Antler Shed Hunting NEW!!** You never know what you might discover in the woods! Learn the secret to finding beautiful, natural treasures with our very own Lancaster County expert.

**Archery** Whether interested in backyard fun, competition target shooting, or hunting, this course will teach you all the basics! Safety, equipment needs and technique will be covered with hands-on shooting at the indoor and outdoor range.

**Autumn Crock Painting** Learn the basics of painting a decorative crock with an autumn theme. The technique learned can be used to paint almost any type of indoor/outdoor decorative object. *There is an additional \$5 supplies fee for this class.*

**Flyfishing** The Addicted Angler is again teaching this popular class! Master basic flycasting techniques and learn about lines, leaders, knots and fly selection. Participants will become familiar with the necessary equipment for successful angling and discover places to fish.

**Garden Scene Investigation** Behind the scenes of any garden will help you in identifying some of the most troublesome garden pests. You will explore the signs and symptoms of key insects and diseases and which crops are vulnerable.

**Glass Twisting** Don Kelley will be back again—but only for one class!. Take home your own glass twisted ornament! Class limited to 12; preference given to new students. *There is an additional \$5 supplies fee for this class.*

**GPS & Compass** Another popular class! Learn how to read a compass, use a GPS and become a “geocacher” - a popular Internet-based treasure hunt that is fun for the whole family.

**Handguns** Thinking about buying self protection? Want to learn target shooting? From basic safety to firearm types, learn how to safely and comfortably handle handguns.

**Shotgunning/Trap** Become familiar with different types of shotguns, ammunitions and proper fit then head out to the range to give it a try! It's a blast!
