## CLASSES TO CHOOSE FROM:

**NEW! Soap Crafting:** Also known as "melt & pour soap making". In this hands-on class you will learn 3 popular techniques. We will start with a pre-made glycerin soap that you will melt, mix and add scent, ground oatmeal and powered goat's milk. We will discuss interesting things you can put into your soap, and finally you will see how to package your works of art to impress. All students will take home handouts and 2 bars of soap ready to use or to give away as a gift. \$5 additional class fee required.

**NEW! Wild Incredible Edibles:** Enjoy the unique flavors of some of the most common wild edibles one might find outdoors. Focus on native plants, berries and flowers with edible and other uses, getting down the basics of wild food usage and study. Come see what nature has to offer.

**NEW! Reading the Weather:** Nature gives us a lot of signs of changing weather. You will learn how to forecast the weather using these signs and how to read a weather map to plan anything else you do in the outdoors. This will be hands-on. Through this you will become more knowledgeable of what happens with the weather.

**NEW! Forest Ecology and Tree Identification:** Were you ever curious about why certain types of plants grow in a forest and what their role was in keeping the forest habitat healthy? You will get hands-on practice identifying trees while exploring the beauty and diversity our forests offer.

**NEW! Knots:** The art of tying knots is well known in small circles of fisherman, sailors, hikers and paddlers and can sometimes make little sense to the rest of us; like any craft or science, there's plenty of knot jargon to learn.

**NEW! Whitetail Deer 101/Sportmanship:** This course is for those hunters interested in gaining sufficient skills to perform an ethical hunt. You will increase your knowledge of ethical, responsible and safe-hunting practices. Emphasis will be made on shot placement and anatomy of the whitetail deer. You'll also learn about game care, hunting methods/techniques and proper equipment.

**NEW! Advanced Turkey Hunting Tactics 201:** This class will focus on all aspects of spring turkey hunting including; set-ups, calling tactics, equipment, techniques, woodsmanship, weather related tactics, ethics and safety.

**NEW! Tree Stand Hunting/Safety:** Hunting from above gives us several advantages, such as remaining above a deer's normal field of view, raising our scent above our prey's nose and increasing our range of vision. You will learn which tree stand is best for you and how to use the equipment necessary for ascending and descending, also, how to get back into the stand after the fall. This is a hands and feet on class, actual climbing will be done.

**Basic Turkey Hunting & Calling 101:** The more experience you have using calls, the better your odds are for finding and taking turkeys. At this class, you'll learn about turkeys and how to call. In no time, you will be confident that you can call in a turkey!

**Fly Fishing:** You will learn the basics of fly fishing techniques. The course offers information which will help you select a rod and reel, line weights, baits and lures.

**Fishing:** Develop basic skills needed to catch fish: casting, lure selection, fish identification, fishing locations and equipment choice and use.

**Archery:** Experience the thrill of hitting the mark! Whether you're interested in backyard recreation, competition target shooting or bow-hunting, learn about equipment selection and get lots of hands-on instruction at the range.

**Handguns:** The instructor will provide a broad spectrum of information about the operations and fundamentals of shooting handguns. At the end of this class, you will be able to safely shoot a variety of handguns.

**Rifle:** Learn to shoot .22 rim fire rifles and the fundamentals of marksmanship skills. Come join us for fun and action on the firing range!

**Shotgunning/Trapshoot:** You will become familiar with different types of shotguns, ammunition, proper gun fit, and gun cleaning. Time will be spent at the range where you will shoot clay birds.

**Outdoor Cooking:** Cooking in the great outdoors is a big adventure for most. A good starting point is to learn a few basic outdoor cooking methods as well as types of equipment. So sit back, relax and let master outdoor chef, Mike Vaka, bring out the culinary genius in you!

**Get Your Bearings:** Getting lost in the woods will no longer be a threat to your outdoor adventure. In this course, you will learn how to read a compass and topographic maps.

**Outdoor Survival Skills:** Gain the knowledge, skill, and attitude that surviving an outdoor emergency requires. This course will deal with the mental things you need to know about survival as well as the physical aspects: food, water and shelter.
